

The Nomad Stove

- For a speedy start up you will need to build a small open pile of tinder and kindling. The best way of doing this is to lay pencil thick sticks across the firebox so that they are propped alternately against either side to form a V- shaped platform. On top of this place your kindling and any firestarter.
- Keep the fire small but fast burning. Use sticks no thicker than a finger but preferably around pencil thickness. Better to constantly feed sticks in rather than try to add a large pile of fuel in one go.
- Do not use too big a pan. Make sure you leave a gap at the back of the stove so that air can flow up and draw the flames around the pan.
- The stove will warp during use, but most of this will reverse if you allow the stove to cool naturally after use. Even if you have to douse the stove with water the warping will not affect the performance- enough tolerance has been built in to allow for this distortion.
